How Our Sorting & Recovery Process Works

A careful, compassionate system for separating belongings, recovering important items, and restoring order.

If clothes are mixed in with clutter, or an emergency situation caused items to get jumbled, we use a step-by-step process to sort everything carefully and help locate the essentials that matter most.



1



Identify Priorities First

We begin by asking what matters most: medications, paperwork, valuables, sentimental items, clothing, keys, phones, glasses, and daily essentials.

Set Up Sorting Zones

We create clear categories such as Keep, Donate, Trash, Laundry/Clothing, Important Papers, Valuables, and Items Needing Your Review.

Careful Hands-On Sorting

We go area by area so items are not missed. Clothing is separated from trash and clutter, loose belongings are grouped, and mixed items are sorted with care.

Locate Important Essentials

If something critical is missing, such as prescription medications near a bed or nightstand, we focus on those zones first and set important finds aside in a safe, visible place for your review.

5



Client Review & Approval

We communicate throughout the process so you can review important categories and confirm what stays, what goes, and what needs extra attention.

6



Final Removal & Reset

Once approved, we remove discard items, consolidate what stays, and leave the area far more usable, accessible, and manageable.
